1990 Criteria for the Classification of Giant Cell (Temporal) Arteritis

Criteria	Definition
_____ 1. Age at disease onset ≥ 50 years	Development of symptoms or findings beginning at age 50 or older
_____ 2. New headache	New onset of or new type of localized pain in the head
_____ 3. Temporal artery abnormality	Temporal artery tenderness to palpation or decreased pulsation, unrelated to arteriosclerosis of cervical arteries
_____ 4. Elevated erythrocyte sedimentation rate	Erythrocyte sedimentation rate ≥ 50 mm/hour by the Westergren method
_____ 5. Abnormal artery biopsy	Biopsy specimen with artery showing vasculitis characterized by a predominance of mononuclear cell infiltration or granulomatous inflammation, usually with multinucleated giant cells

* For purposes of classification, a patient shall be said to have giant cell (temporal) arteritis if at least 3 of these 5 criteria are present. The presence of any 3 or more criteria yields a sensitivity of 93.5% and a specificity of 91.2%
